HFU Business School again offers Women's Scholarships in 2019

Women are still in the minority in management in Germany. To support their goal of helping more women achieve management positions, for several years now the HFU Business School has been awarding women's scholarships for their part-time Executive MBA Program. Currently we are offering three partial scholarships for this English-taught general management program which starts again in March 2019. The Executive MBA Program – run on the Schwenningen Campus centrally located between Stuttgart, Constance and Freiburg – awards the internationally recognized Master of Business Administration (MBA) degree. The program is fully accredited by the prestigious international accreditation agency ACQUIN.

This professional development program focuses on strengthening interdisciplinary and intercultural know-how which is practical and workplace relevant. This is particularly important for the export-oriented German market. For this reason the Executive MBA also includes two one-week modules abroad, one in China and one in Spain.

Type of scholarship

The scholarship is aimed at highly motivated women in management positions, or women targeting such positions upon graduation from our program. Candidates should have above-average academic qualifications and be able to demonstrate professional achievement. The small group size of maximum 15 participants allows enough flexibility for customization of the course and long-term planning, making it ideal for candidates preparing to return to work after maternity leave. The on-campus days of Friday and Saturday, usually twice a month during the semester, as well as two modules abroad of one week each, can be easily integrated into existing schedules. The program stands out from the crowd because of its on-the-job relevance, providing the best possible preparation for a professional "comeback". The HFU Business School will award up to three partial women's scholarships of €6,000 each for the 2019 part-time Executive MBA Program. This covers one third of the tuition fees.

The Executive MBA partial scholarships for women will be offset against tuition fees, divided equally across the 4 semesters of the Executive MBA Program at the HFU Business School.

Prerequisites for the Executive MBA Program

- » university degree
- » minimum of 5 years professional experience
- » good to very good proficiency in English
- » personal interview

Prerequisites for the Executive MBA Scholarship

- » above-average grades in first university degree
- » demonstrated professional achievement
- » demonstrated financial need
